

Field Gear Recommendations

Antiquity Consulting provides all necessary Personal Protective Equipment and survey equipment, but we have some suggestions on how to appropriately outfit yourself for fieldwork in the Pacific Northwest. Antiquity maintains a stock of supplies to help staff repair and maintain their personal gear, such as waterproofing sprays and rubber patches, and will intermittently provide personal items useful in the field for full-time staff such as water bottles, t-shirts, packs, and hats.

What Antiquity Provides for Surveys

In the course of a typical day on a shovel probe survey, you will use the following provided by Antiquity:

- Tablet
- Gloves
- Compass
- Artifact scale
- Metric rule
- Trowel
- Pruners
- Saw
- Screen
- Shovel
- Breaker bar
- Bucket auger

Recommended Personal Gear

There are some items that are preferred for personal use, or that cannot reasonably be shared by crew and maintained by Antiquity. These are items you may be keeping in your personal pack or on your body.

- Food
- Water
- Liquid IV
- Handwarmers
- Sunscreen
- Bug repellant
- First aid
- Tissues
- Hair ties
- Medicine
- Female urination device
- Menstrual hygiene
- Pack, dry bag preferred
- Boots
- Layered clothing: expect to encounter thick vegetation including blackberries almost every day.
 - Full length pants
 - Full length shirt/outer layer
- Rain gear
 - Waterproof hiking boots
 - Rain/muck boots for intertidal settings
 - Rain pants
 - Rubberized rain jacket
